COMMUNITY HEALTH ASSESSMENT AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT
Focus on Nutrition & Physical Activity, Behavioral Health, and Healthy Aging

GREENFIELD, Wis. — Residents and community partners have worked collaboratively with the Greenfield Health Department to develop the recently released draft community health assessment. Beginning with a review of community-level data, the Healthiest Greenfield Coalition has met several times over the past year – in both the large group and smaller topical task forces – to determine the potential health priorities for the City of Greenfield.

“This draft community health assessment represents a year of deliberation and assessment,” states Darren Rausch, Health Officer/Director. “Participation among Coalition members has been robust throughout the process. Now it’s time to share the draft to hear the voices of others in the community.”

The draft assessment will be available for review on the City’s website (www.cityofgreenfieldwi.us). Feedback will be obtained through a survey tool (<https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/GFassess17>) until Friday, April 14. Feedback will be reviewed and the draft assessment will be updated accordingly.

The Greenfield Board of Health will endorse the Community Health Assessment at their May 11, 2017, meeting. This meeting will be held at 6:30 pm at Greenfield City Hall, Room 105.

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
